**HUSBAND - John Deveraux**

In the 1870 United States Federal Census for Utah, John is listed as age 65, living in Newton, Utah County, had a wife named Anne, age 60, his occupation, farmer, owned personal estate worth \$200 and property valued at \$275, could read and write and his birthplace was England.

In the 1880 United States Federal Census for Utah, Place: Goshen, Utah, Utah, John Deverax Head Male age 78 born England, Farmer, Parents born England. Ann Devarax Wife Female Age 70 born England, Keeping House, parents born England

**CHILD 1 - Paul Cockshutt Deveraux**

Paul Cockshutt Deveraux was born before his parents married but John Deveraux was his father. The official parish record for Dymock, Gloucestershire, England on 28 Jan 1821 records the baptish of Paul Cockshutt and names his father as John Deveraux.

**CHILD 6 - Emanuel Deveraux**

In the 1851 Bromsberrow, Gloucestershire, census: Manuel Devereux Status: Servant Age 15. Occ: Waggoners Boy. Born Eastnor, Herefordshire. Living with the Wintle family.
